

The May meeting of the Cady Town Board was held on Monday, May 2, 2016 at 8 p.m. at the town hall. All board members were present.

Chairman Tully called the meeting to order. Motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Mikla to accept the April minutes as read. Motion was passed

Public comments were heard concerning garbage & animal carcasses being dumped at the dead end of 53rd ave. Board stated will order a sign concerning littering and will clean up garbage. Landowner Mark Mueller was told carcasses will not be picked up. Board gave Mueller permission to put his camera on town property at his own risk.

Dean Fayerweather the Chairman for the Town of Springfield asked board to look at the Cady WISLR map because they can't get state funding for 60th ave as per their map is different than the towns have been maintaining. Chairman Tully will look at map.

Letter from River falls fire concerning Wedding barns was discussed. Was reminded that town has no ordinance concerning wedding barns.

Motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Klanderman to adopt ordinance #2016-1 regarding legal posting and official newspaper. Motion was passed

Motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Mikla to adopt ordinance #2016-2 concerning public contracts and competitive bidding. Motion was passed.

Board discussed and decided to hold off paving 30th ave this year instead to use money for seal coating etc. to maintain several other roads. Roger Timm gave an update on the roads including will have to dig out several soft spots in different roads to replace with new rock. Also box culvert on 320th was discussed.

Bills were reviewed and paid.

Motion to adjourn was made by Chairman Tully, second by Supervisor Mikla. Motion passed.
