

The Cady Town board met Monday, May 3, 2010 at 8:00 pm at the town hall. All board members were present except Treasurer Trealoff. Gay Wang also attended.

Chairman Tully called the meeting to order. Motion was made by Supervisor Timm and second by Supervisor Hampton to accept the April minutes as read. Motion was passed.

Bills were reviewed and paid. Recycling grant is going to be \$2320.77 for FY10

Clerk Greiber updated the board on retention of assessment records. Records must be maintained for at least 50 years to check for lands enrolled in PFC if the owner of the property wished to withdraw from the program. The records are used to assess any penalties to be imposed .
