

The Cady Town board met Monday, June 7, 2010 at 8:00 pm at the town hall. All board members were present.

Chairman Tully called the meeting to order. The minutes from the May meeting were read and corrected to read Treasurer Trealoff was not at the May meeting. Motion was made by Supervisor Timm and second by Supervisor Hampton to accept the May minutes as corrected. Motion was passed.

Bills were reviewed and paid. The bill from Bakke Norman for Assessor Olson was sent on to Rural Insurance on the advice of the Town attorney, Cathy Munkittrick.

Motion was made by Supervisor Timm and second by Supervisor Hampton to accept 26 Operator's licenses applications which are for Kwik Trip and Stockman Farm Supply. Motion was passed.

Assessor Kleven's 2011 contract was presented. Motion was made by Chairman Tully with a second by Supervisor Timm to sign the maintenance contract which pays Assessor Kleven \$6900 for his services. Motion was passed.

Discussion was held on the disposal of appliances at the Town Hall. Motion was made by Chairman Tully with a second by Supervisor Timm to charge \$10 for each appliance or large item made of metal. Motion was passed. These will be picked up by CCR when enough items have been acquired to fill a truck.

A question was raised on putting a driveway sign on 270th St. for the Langer driveway. The driveway entrance and road are in the Town of Eau Galle.

Chairman Tully has contacted WI Salt Solutions. Calcium Chloride will be put on the gravel roads when Wayne Samuel has the roads graded.

Discussion was held on paving and seal coating. Pierce St Croix Rd will be paved (1.12 miles) and two miles of road will be seal coated. The two miles to be seal coated will be determined once an inspection of the roads is complete. Seal coating is about \$15,000/mile; paving is close to \$90,000/mile.

Clerk Greiber informed the board that an address sign is needed for a new home. The new sign style will be purchased from now on. Supervisor Timm will talk with Wayne Samuel about the sign purchase.

Next board meeting will be July 5, 2010 at 8:00 pm

Motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Timm, second by Chairman Tully. Motion passed.
