

ORDINANCE ADOPTING FIRE PROTECTION CHARGES

The Town Board of the Town of Cady, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Title 7 >Chapter 1

Sec 7-1-1 PURPOSE

(a) The intent is to implement the procedures to charge property owners in the Town for fire protection services.

Sec. 7-1-2 AUTHORITY

(a) Pursuant to Sections 60.55, 60.555 and 60.557 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Cady, St. Croix County, hereby established the following policy and procedure for the payment of fire costs incurred by the Town of Cady.

Sec 7-1-3 LIABILITY FOR FIRE PROTECTION COSTS

(a) The property owners of real estate within the Town of Cady for which fire protection is provided shall be responsible for the costs of the fire calls made to the property based upon the actual amount billed the Town of Cady by the fire department provider which provides the fire protection service to the subject real estate and/or personal property. This includes the cost of other departments or providers responding at the request of an authorized department under mutual aid.

Sec 7-1-4 BILLING AND PAYMENT PROCEDURE

(a) The costs of fire calls as outlined above shall be billed by the Town Treasurer to the property owner and paid to the Town Treasurer within 60 days of the date of the invoice. The failure to pay the invoice within 60 days will result in interest being charged at the rate of 1.5% per month (18% per annum) from the date of the invoice. Those invoices remaining outstanding, plus any interest accrued, for more than 90 days as of November 1 of any year shall be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent special charge pursuant to Section 66.60 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Sec. 7-1-5 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law


