St. Croix County Asks Residents to Report Spring Thaw Damage

St. Croix County Emergency Management is encouraging people with water damage, due to the spring thaw, to either report damages online here: https://211wisconsin.communityos.org/damage-report or by calling 2-1-1. The information will be used by St. Croix County Emergency Support Services to assess the amount of damage to private resident homes and businesses. Emergencies, such as life safety assistance, should be requested through 9-1-1.

It is not known at this time if there will be any financial assistance provided from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), grants, loans or other sources. While residents should not count on this funding, everyone is encouraged to keep record of all expenses and take pictures of damages in the event there is any reimbursement or funding opportunities offered in the future. This is the first step in gathering information so we understand what, where, how much, and what type of damage has occurred.

Please understand that submitting a 2-1-1 form or calling 2-1-1 does not guarantee assistance, but is a crucial first step in determining if people may be eligible for disaster assistance programs possibly available in the future. Much of the flooding is about drainage issues. The ground is saturated and frozen and has nowhere to go. Areas that normally do not see flooding have standing water that is moving into buildings and over roadways.
