Motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Klanderman to adopt Resolution 2020-1 to abandon 10th ave east of Highway 128. Motion was passed

Road update -including will not continue with grant application for June flood damage at Cady Creek bridge. Hope to purchase next year gravel this year.

Bills were reviewed and paid.

Next board meeting will be by November 2nd immediately following the 7:00pm budget meeting.
