General Information About Your Property Tax

When Are My Taxes Due?

Your entire real estate tax bill or your first installment is due by January 31, 2021. If you choose to pay installments, your first installment is due by January 31, 2021 and your second installment is due by July 31, 2021. Note that the amount of your installments might vary. If you fail to pay first installment amount, at the correct time to the correct place, you will incur additional charges.

How Can I Pay?

You have two options to make the payment due January 31, 2021:

Pay by Mail: Make your check payable to the Town of Cady, enclose the payment stub(s), and mail to:

Pay in Person: Taxes can be paid at the Cady Town Hall:

Saturday, January 23, 2021
8:00 AM-12:00 PM
Wednesday, January 27, 2021
5:00-7:00 PM

There will be no taxes collected at the town hall on January 30 due to the uncertainty of the weather and the close tax deadline date of January 31.

Multiple parcel payments can be combined on one check.

Due to COVID-19, I will not be taking payments at my home. If you wish to drop off a payment, you may.

How Can I Get A Receipt?

Enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your payment and tax stub. Another choice, every two weeks the county posts the payments. Payments can be found at:

What happens if I pay late?

By state law, if you fail to pay the entire amount of your first installment by January 31, 2021, then the option to pay installments is no longer available. The entire balance becomes due and will accrue interest and penalty of 1.5% per month until the amount is paid in full.

What if I cannot pay my entire first installment amount?

We encourage everyone to try to pay at least the amount of their first installment to avoid interest and penalty. It is in your best interest to pay as much as you can by the due date. Continuing to make monthly payments until the entire balance is paid will help reduce the amount of interest and penalty. Unpaid property tax can lead to lose of property.

When am I eligible for a Lottery Credit?

If this property was your primary residence on January 1, 2020, please check your tax bill to verify you received this credit. If not, you can still apply with the Town Treasurer BEFORE January 31, 2020. It is best to apply before or when you pay your tax payment. Remember that you may only have one lottery credit.

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
