The Cady Town board met September 6, 2022 at 7:00 pm . All board members except Clerk Ninneman were in attendance.

Conflict of Interest and Procurement Policies were discussed. It was decided that Title 2, Chapter 6, Government and Administration covers the Code of Ethics covers the conflict of interest part and our Public Contracts and Competitive Bidding ordinance covers the procurement part. If the Town applies for a road grant, the Town will then consider adopting a policy for amounts spent over \$250,000.

Road update by Patrolman Timm. Roads have been chip sealed and culverts replaced. Nothing from Haas on the driveway permit request. A resident has been using the roads to exercise his horses, making holes in the gravel. Chairman Tully will talk with the resident,

Bills were reviewed and paid. Motion was made by Supervisor Mikla and second by Chairman Tully to add the cost of an RV fire on Cty N to the property owner's taxes if the bill is not paid before November.
